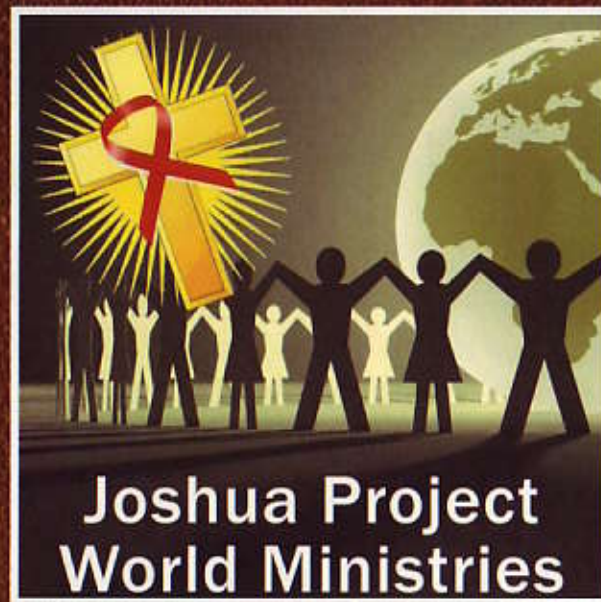

Our Ministries

Day Center—located in Resita, this facility houses our Dental, Counseling, and Bible Study programs. At the Day Center, our youth not only have access to these programs but also have a place where they can relax and feel at home.

Dental Clinic—located in the Day Center, we are able to provide free dental care to those infected with HIV/AIDS. Many come to us needing anything from a simple cleaning to a new set of teeth, and during this time we are also able to share the love of Jesus Christ with them.

Summer Camp—Each year, teams from the US, Canada, and Ireland join us to host summer camps for our youth. Many lives are changed for Christ as they see and feel the love of Jesus communicated during this time.

Open Hearts—Ministry which provides clothing and school supplies to a needy school in a village near Resita.

Operation Christmas Bag—Through sponsors, we provide Christmas packages to over 400 children/families living in or around Resita.

Youth Church—Every Friday night, we host a time of worship, prayer, and discussion with youth from our center as well as others in Resita.

Hospital Ministry—Each week, fresh food is delivered to the HIV/AIDS infected children in Timisoara Infectious Disease Hospital.

Every-Child-A-Home Ministry—Through partnership with sponsors, we are able to provide a simple living for our youth in need.
