Questions to consider

When it comes to your personality, are you someone who would rather simply pay to have something done or are you someone who is willing to put in the “sweat equity” and take on a fixer upper?

Take a closer look at [Acts 5:12-42](#). In this passage we learn from the apostles that bold obedience often triggers opposition, releases God’s miracle, and always requires faith. How can you draw encouragement from the apostles’ example of courageous obedience in this chapter?

What is keeping you from boldly obeying God in the way the apostles did in [Acts 5](#)? How can you go about removing these barriers? Are you willing to make those changes?
